


2 - Tutor Matching:

We identify a specialist tutor (or tutors) with the right expertise and experience and begin planning.

4. Ongoing Communication:

Each term, schools receive a detailed progress report for every student.

3. Start of Provision:

Once agreed, tuition begins, either in person or online, with regular attendance updates and lesson reports.

When a **specialist schoo**l contacted us, several of their **students** were **unable to attend** due to **high levels of anxiety**.

Initial consultation: £125 per student


